

Full-time, Part-time, and Correspondence Courses



Full-time Courses (Zennichi-sei)

Monday~Friday 8:30a.m.~3:30p.m.(6 hours)

Part-time Courses (Teiji-sei)

Day

Night

Students can suitably balance their school studies and work hours.

Correspondence Courses (Tsushin-sei)

Study at home and send "reports" to school.

Also 2~5 "schooling" classes a month at school.

Types of Courses at Public High Schools

(P6)

General Course (*Futsu-ka*)

Specialized Course (*Senmon gakka*)

Comprehensive Course (Sogo gakka)

General Course

Suitable for those who want to more thoroughly study what they covered in junior high school, such as Japanese, mathematics, social studies, science, and English.

Specialized Course

(P6)

- Agriculture, industry, commerce, fisheries, home economics, nursing, etc.
- Can gain certifications.
- Suitable for students who have a clear idea of what they would like to do in the future.

Comprehensive Course



- Students comprehensively study subjects from both general and specialized courses.
- They can choose subjects which match their interests or ones needed for future plans.

The "High School Tuition Support Fund" will be paid for students whose parents make less than approximately 9.1 million yen per year. (Neither the student nor the parents themselves will directly receive the payment.)
