




What are "Common Selection" and "Feature Selection?"





With "Common Selection," schools choose after looking at the academic test points and evaluation score.

With "Feature Selection," in addition to the academic test points and evaluation score, each respevtive high school also considers interviews, practical test, and what is written on the evaluation report, based on desired features.
